TRANSIT: We provide one-on-one trip planning and bus schedules to get you to your destination.
ECO-PASS: A program for employers who are interested in offering their employees a reduced-cost transit benefit. The Eco-Pass is an annual unlimited ride pass.
PARK & RIDE: We help commuters find convenient lots and times.
PARKING CASH OUT: We support businesses on implementing state law 37-5.7.1, which requires certain employers who provide subsidized parking for their employees to offer a RIPTA transit pass in lieu of a parking space.
CARPPOOLING: Use our free AlterNetRide carpool matching software to find carpool companions. Discounted Downtown Parking (for carpools). We provide secure indoor parking at Providence Place Mall.

Cash Fare for Buses & Trolleys • \$2.00 per Ride
Children under 5 ride free when accompanied by an adult.
1-Day Pass • \$6 • Valid Statewide
Unlimited rides. Good for 24 hrs. from time of purchase. Purchase on buses and trolleys only.
7-Day Pass • \$23 • Valid Statewide
Unlimited rides. Good for 7 consecutive days from time of purchase. Purchase on buses and trolleys only.
15 Ride Pass • \$26
Includes transfers.
Monthly Pass • \$62
Unlimited rides for entire month.

SENIORS & PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES
Seniors and people with disabilities receive reduced fare during off-peak hours with their RIPTA Reduced Fare Bus Pass or Medicare Card. Senior/Disabled Reduced Fare: \$1.00 (off peak) Transfer: .25¢ (off peak). Low income seniors and people with disabilities can qualify for a RIPTA No Fare Bus Pass.
